

Cookie Usage Agreement

1.1. This Cookie Usage Agreement (hereinafter – the Agreement) sets forth the rules governing the use of cookies and similar technologies on the website of the virtual asset exchange service (hereinafter – the Website).

1.2. By accessing or using the Website, you acknowledge and agree to the use of cookies in accordance with the provisions of this Agreement. Should you disagree with the use of cookies, you may modify your browser settings accordingly or discontinue use of the Website.

2. Definition of Cookies

2.1. Cookies are small text files stored on your device, including but not limited to computers, tablets, and mobile devices, when you visit the Website. Cookies enable the Website to recognize your device and retain information regarding user preferences, configurations, and interactions.

2.2. Cookies may be classified as session cookies, which are automatically deleted upon closure of the browser, or persistent cookies, which remain stored on the device for a defined period or until manually deleted by the user.

3. Purposes of Cookie Usage

The Website utilizes cookies for the following purposes:

Ensuring proper operation of the Website. Certain cookies are strictly necessary for the functioning of core Website features, including user authentication, security mechanisms, and transaction processing.

Analytics and service enhancement. Cookies facilitate the collection of information regarding user behavior and interaction patterns, enabling the improvement of Website performance, structure, and functionality.

Personalization. Cookies allow the Website to store user preferences, including interface settings and language selection, thereby enhancing the user experience.

Marketing and advertising. Cookies may be employed to deliver content, including promotional materials and advertising, tailored to user interests and to evaluate the effectiveness of marketing initiatives.

4. Categories of Cookies Used

– Strictly Necessary Cookies. These cookies are essential for the operation of the Website and its fundamental functions. Disabling such cookies may result in limited Website functionality.

- Functional Cookies. These cookies retain user settings and preferences to improve usability and user experience.
- Analytical Cookies. These cookies collect information regarding Website traffic, user navigation, and usage patterns. The Website may utilize third-party analytical services for the processing of such data.
- Advertising Cookies. These cookies are used to deliver advertisements and promotional content relevant to user interests and may be placed by authorized advertising partners.

4.1 Cookie Retention Periods

- Strictly Necessary Cookies. Retained for the duration of the session or for a period not exceeding thirty days where required to ensure the proper operation and security of the Website.
- Functional Cookies. Retained for a period not exceeding one year to enable the preservation of user preferences and settings.
- Analytical Cookies. Retained for a period not exceeding twenty-six months for analytical and service improvement purposes.

Users may delete cookies at any time through the browser settings applicable to their device.

5. Cookie Management

5.1. Users may manage the use of cookies by modifying the settings of their web browser.

5.2. Users acknowledge that disabling certain categories of cookies may affect the functionality of the Website and may restrict access to specific features or sections thereof.

5.3. Withdrawal of Consent to Cookie Usage

Users shall have the right to withdraw their consent to the use of cookies at any time.

Withdrawal of consent may be effected by:

- modifying the browser settings to block or restrict cookies;
- deleting previously stored cookies through the browser settings.

Users acknowledge that the withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of data processing carried out prior to such withdrawal.

6. Third-Party Cookies

6.1. The Website may utilize third-party cookies provided by external service providers for the purposes of traffic analysis, performance monitoring, and user behavior assessment.

6.2. The Company implements reasonable measures to ensure an adequate level of personal data protection in connection with the use of third-party technologies, including, inter alia:

- the application of standard contractual safeguards where required;
- the assessment of the data protection standards applied by the relevant service provider;
- the limitation of the scope of data transmitted.

6.3. The Company does not control the operation of third-party cookies and recommends that Users review the privacy and cookie policies of the respective third-party service providers for further information.

7. Profiling and Automated Processing

7.1 The Website may employ cookies and similar technologies to perform profiling based on User interactions and behavior. Such profiling may include analysis of, inter alia:

- page visitation history;
- user preferences relating to virtual assets or exchange parameters;
- frequency and volume of transactions;
- duration and patterns of Website usage.

7.2. Profiling activities may be conducted for the purposes of:

- personalization of Website functionality and user experience;
- optimization of services and transaction parameters;
- detection and prevention of fraudulent or unauthorized activities.

8. Amendments to the Agreement

8.1. The Company reserves the right to amend this Agreement at its discretion. Any amendments shall be published on the Website. Continued use of the Website following such publication shall constitute acceptance of the amended terms.
